Stop at the first finding for any injury < 24 hours old.

	TEAM TRAUMA ALERT, ADULT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Penetrating injury of extremity with concern for vascular injury -femur deformity/fracture or 2 or more proximal long bone fractures (exclude hip) -Fall > 20 feet (>10 feet for a child) -Burns > 15% TBSA -amputations below wrist or ankle(excluding digits) - pedestrian struck at > 15 mph -motorcycle crash > 20 mph or with separation of rider from bike -GCS 9 – 12 with mechanism of injury attributed to trauma - transfer patient on ventilator or with GCS <15 and intracranial injury -Patients with reduced physiologic reserve. Especially patients over age 65 with known coagulopathy, pre-existing medical conditions or mechanism of injury that places them at risk for abdominal or thoracic injury. TRAUMA ACTIVATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> --Cardiac arrest after trauma -- airway obstruction or compromise -- intubated from scene -- Confirmed BP <90 at any time, <u>or</u> age specific hypotension SBP <70 +(2x age in years) --Penetrating injury to neck, chest or abdomen -- GCS≤ 8 with mechanism attributed to trauma -- spinal cord injury or limb paralysis -- amputation above the wrist or ankle -- transfer patients receiving blood to maintain vital signs or on inotropic support 	Pediatric Surgery (PS)Attending Pediatric Trauma Team Anesthesia Attending Anesthesia Resident Respiratory Therapist Radiology Technologist PICU Attending OR and Blood Bank are notified.
